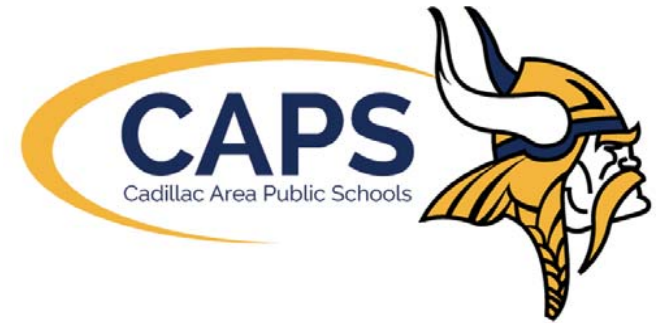

Cost to Homeowners

This proposal was developed after many discussions with the community and an in-depth study of CAPS facility needs. To meet those needs in a financially responsible way, the Board of Education has proposed a 3.9 mill increase that, if approved, would generate \$68,915,000 million for the school district.

Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.
