The Clubhouse is also open for half-days and school delays.

Hours are 6:30 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. CAPS Clubhouse is a member of the Michigan Department of Education Child and Adult Care Food program and provides a nutritious breakfast between 6:30 –8:00 a.m. and both a morning and after-school snack. Students may bring a sack lunch or purchase a school lunch. Income eligible families may receive this lunch free or at reduced prices.
