FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Everyone loves to talk about his or her own experiences. When you invite your child to speak about his or her life, you help them in several ways—you increase their self-esteem, develop vocabulary, and show them that stories have a beginning, a middle, and an end. Invite your child to share their life stories by making and sharing Story Scrolls.

- Help your child think of an exciting event they have experienced, such as a trip, sporting event, birthday or holiday.
- Help your child break the event into parts by telling what happened first, second, third, fourth....last.
- Invite your child to illustrate each part of the story on a separate piece of paper.
- Place the pictures side-by-side in order and tape them together.
- Tape the edge of the first picture to an empty paper towel roll. Tape the last picture to the end of a second tube.
- Start with the last picture and roll the pictures right to left. The first tube serves as the handle.

Gather the family and invite your child to narrate as he or she unrolls the scroll and tells the story the pictures reveal.

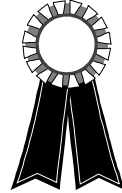
