Please.....

.....*Send a note to school with your child in the morning when he/she will be going home with someone else, or in any way that is different from the normal after school plan. If you would like your child to wait for you after school instead of riding the bus, you MUST send a note with your child. Students without notes will be sent home by the usual after school mode of transportation.*

.....*Call 876-5100 before 3:00 p.m. if you have a last minute need to change your child's after school bus or pick-up plans. This gives us time to get a note to the classroom before the end of the school day.*

.....*Keep your child home until he/she is fever free for 24 hours. If your child is vomiting, he/she should not be sent to school until vomiting has stopped for 24 hours.*

.....*Continue to monitor your child at home for head lice infestations. We have had several reported cases at Forest View and would like to stop the spread of head lice as soon as possible. School-wide head checks were conducted this week at school by the Health Department..*

.....*Snow should not be thrown at school. Please discuss this policy at home with your child.*
