CAPS CLUBHOUSE

CAPS Clubhouse is available for your child right here at Forest View School. Children 4 yrs. old through 5th grade may attend our CAPS Before/After School Enrichment Program. The Clubhouse is also open for half-days and school delay days.

Hours are 6:30 am until 6:00 pm. CAPS Clubhouse is a member of the Michigan Department of Education Child and Adult Care Food program and provides a nutritious breakfast between 6:30 –8:00 am and both a morning and after-school snack. Students may bring a sack lunch or purchase a school lunch. Income eligible families may receive this lunch free or at reduced prices.
